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The Gift of Sight 2017 - 18

The "Gift of Sight"- as the name itself signifies is the most wonderful gift you can ever give to the visually impaired. The need for care and treatment for avoidable blindness is very severe in the rural areas of Nepal. Thus to address this problem Rotary Club of Kathmandu Mid-Town teamed up with Hetauda Community Eye Hospital and Rotary Club of Makawanpur to carry out this year's "Gift of Sight " eye camp.

Altogether 1150 patients were screened and 214 were operated with Free Intra Ocular lens implant. The eye camp project was a big success.

This year's "Gift of Sight" eye camp took place from 22nd to 27th of February 2018. As in the past, the eye camp was financially supported by Rotary Club of Garden City Singapore, RI District 3310; Past President C C Chong; Rotary Club of Tainan East RI District 3470; Rotary Club of Taipei Yuanshan, RI District 3520; Rotary Club of Taipak Kenghok, RI District 3480.

The publicity of the camp was mainly done through posters, miking in the village with the help of the local volunteers and also through the local FM radios. Prescreening of the patients were carried out from 4th of February 2018. Altogether 1150 patients were prescreened in the following villages:

- 4th February 2018 – Inawasira village of Bara District - 290 patients
- 7th February 2018 – Chhatiwan village of Makawanpur District - 96 patients
- 9th of February 2018 – Bharta village of Makawanpur District - 72 patients
- 12th of February 2018 – Madhuwan village of Bara District - 380 patients
- 18th of February 2018 – Dhiyal village of Makawanpur District - 70 patients
- 20th of February 2018 – Kolbi village of Bara District - 242 patients

The Gift of Sight Eye Camp was held in Hetauda Eye Hospital. Busses were arranged to bring the identified patients from the villages to the hospital for the surgery. Free accomodation and the meal were provided to the patients in the camp. After the surgery, a proper counselling were given regarding eye care to all the patients before they were discharged. The patients were also given an eye seal and medication. A follow up will be carried out after a month from the date of surgery.

Once again we would like to thank all the members of Rotary Club of Garden City, Singapore and her sister clubs for their generous financial contribution to carry out this meaningful project.
